WERU accepts and appreciates contributions from businesses and non-profit organizations in exchange for radio announcements identifying the business or organization as a WERU Business Supporter. These announcements are a great way to connect with WERU listeners and support Community Radio at the same time.

Please see the Business Supporter announcement rates below. Announcements must adhere to FCC non-commercial regulations and generally fit the following pattern:

“Support for WERU comes from ABC Company of Blue Hill, providing letters and numbers since 1988. More information at abc.com.”

\$200/single payment or \$18.50/month

* \$200 Business Supporters may opt to be thanked only during our 4 Pledge Drives rather than monthly.

Short-term Rates (10 announcement minimum, for publicizing events only):

- Payment may be made by automatic monthly credit card deduction, electronic funds transfer, or as a single payment by check or credit card.
- Full-year Business Supporters at the \$475 level or higher who pay in advance receive a 10% discount on weekly announcement rates.
- Nonprofit organizations receive a 10% discount on weekly announcement rates.
- Businesses that commit to support for an entire year at the \$200 level or higher are listed on the WERU website, thanked on the air, and receive a WERU Business Supporter window decal and framed certificate.
- To the best of our ability, announcements may be scheduled at times that the Business Supporter requests.
